

JEWELJET™

Bring Home the Brilliance!™



Do not steam clean jewelry with loose stones or porous stones such as opal, emerald, turquoise or pearl. If in doubt, ask your local jeweler.

STEP 1: PRE-SOAKING

Using enclosed Fill Cup, add 1 Fizzy Tablet and regular tap water to the cup's fill line. **Do not put Fizzy Tablets into the Jewel Jet!** Soak jewelry until fizzing stops then discard water and rinse the Fill Cup.

STEP 2: SET UP

Make sure the Jewel Jet is unplugged. Unscrew the Fill Cap on top. Pour water into the Fill Cup to the "Max Fill" line. **Do not overfill** as this will cause water to sputter from the nozzle. Pour water into the tank and screw the Fill Cap back on firmly.

STEP 3: OPERATION

Plug in the Jewel Jet. The light on the front of the unit will blink red for a few minutes and then turn blue when the unit is ready. **Do not try to remove Fill Cap when hot!** Place Fill Cup and Basket back into their housing.



STEP 4: STEAM CLEANING

Always use the Locking Tweezers to hold your jewelry. **Keep hands and fingers away from the hot nozzle when cleaning!** While firmly holding jewelry with the Locking Tweezers, press the "Steam" button on top using short bursts in 10 second intervals to allow steam pressure to rebuild. For best results, hold jewelry close to the Steam Nozzle where steam temperature is hottest.

STEP 5: WHEN FINISHED

The Jewel Jet will automatically power off after 10 minutes of non-use. Press the "Steam" button to turn back on. **Unplug the unit when not in use!**



Unplug and allow remaining water in the Jewel Jet to cool for 30 minutes. Slowly unscrew Fill Cap. If steam starts to escape, allow additional time for water to cool. After removing the Fill Cap, turn upside down and dump remaining water in the sink. Never store Jewel Jet with water remaining in the tank.
